1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Mrs M R Nadolski and D L Steadman and Mr E Dance, Co-opted member. The Executive member for Community, Councillor Mrs C L Hockley, was also unable to attend the meeting.

2. MINUTES

A query was raised regarding minute 9(d) - Barnfield Court being designated a Core Scheme from 4 April 2011. The Director of Community and Streetscene advised that this matter would be subject to further reports being considered by the Board.

A query was raised regarding minute 7(g) and the allocation of a provisional sum of £30,000 to fund the provision of mobility scooter storage in the Council's sheltered housing schemes. The Director of Community and Streetscene advised that a full report would be presented to the Board before any funds were spent. He stressed that the sum allocated was *up to £30,000* and full details regarding charging points etc would be presented to the July meeting of the board.

RESOLVED that the minutes of the meeting of the Housing Tenancy Board held on 24 January 2011, be confirmed and signed as a correct record (<u>ht-110124-</u><u>m</u>).

3. CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Chairman reminded members that this would be the last meeting of the Board in this municipal year and he thanked them for their hard work during 2010/11.

6. REVIEW OF THE ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMME FOR 2010/11 AND FINAL CONSIDERATION OF THE DRAFT WORK PROGRAMME FOR 2011/12

The Board considered a report by the Director of Community and Streetscene, which asked members to review the outcome of the current year 2010/11, finalise the draft work programme for the next year, 2011/12 and submit the draft work programme to the Executive (copy of report <u>ht-110321-r01-tgr</u> circulated with the agenda and appended to the signed minutes).

RESOLVED that:-

- (a) the outcome of the work programme for 2010/11, together with the revision stated, be noted;
- (b) the proposed work programme for 2011/12, together with the revisions stated, be agreed; and
- (c) the proposed work programme for 2011/12 be submitted to the Executive.

7. THE COUNCIL'S APPROACH TO THE DIGITAL SWITCHOVER

The Board considered a report by the Director of Finance and Resources, which provided members with details of the forthcoming digital switchover and the condition of communal aerial systems to block of flats and maisonettes (copy of report <u>ht-110321-r02-cne</u> circulated with the agenda and appended to the signed minutes).

The Board discussed in full the intricacies and possible impact of the digital switchover on the Council. The Director of Community and Streetscene advised that tenants needed to be aware of the options available to them and suggested that a report be presented to a future meeting of the Board.

RESOLVED that the report be noted and a further report be presented to the June meeting of the Board on the options available to tenants.

8. ENERGY SUPPLY AGREEMENT - VOID PROPERTIES

The Board considered a report by the Director of Finance and Resources, which provided members with information relating to an energy provider framework for vacant properties (copy of report <u>ht-110321-r06-cne</u> circulated with the agenda and appended to the signed minutes).

RESOLVED that the report be noted.

9. PERFORMANCE MONITORING - TENANCY SERVICES

The Board Considered a report by The Director of Community and Streetscene, which set out Performance Monitoring data for Tenant Services covering Current Tenant Rent Arrears and Repossessions, Void Property Management including Void Rent Loss, Estate Inspections and Satisfaction levels for Estate Services, Anti-Social Behaviour, Demand for Social Housing, Housing Stock Figures and Lettings, Tenant Consultation and Involvement (copy of report <u>ht-110321-r04-jsh</u> circulated with the agenda and appended to the signed minutes).

The Board congratulated the Director of Community and Streetscene and his team for an excellent report.

RESOLVED that the report be noted.

10. ESTATES IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME 2011/12

The Board considered a report by the Director of Community and Streetscene, which provided members with information on schemes suggested for inclusion in the programme of Estate Improvements for 2011/12. The report also provided members with an update on the schemes approved for 2010/11 (copy of report <u>ht-110321-r05-jsh</u> circulated with the agenda and appended to the signed minutes).

The Board was advised that Comserv UK Ltd were doing an excellent job and tenants were very pleased with their work.

RESOLVED that the information contained in the report be noted and the schemes identified be supported and endorsed.
