Subject: BUILDING CONTROL PARTNERSHIP SERVICE UPDATE

SUMMARY

Changes to England's building regulations aimed at improving the energy efficiency of buildings came into effect on 15 June 2022. These changes apply to new homes, extensions, existing buildings and non-domestic buildings.

The 2022 changes are transitionary measures ahead of the Future Homes and Buildings Standards introduction in 2025, which will require more significant cuts to carbon emissions, to support the Government's target of the UK achieving net zero by 2050.

The Head of the Building Control Partnership will present an overview of these changes alongside the partnership's role in administering them.
