

CLIMATE CHANGE SCRUTINY PANEL
SCOPING REPORT

Issue	Hampshire County Council's approach to reducing carbon emissions and building resilience across Hampshire as a whole.
Background	<p>Hampshire County Council's (HCC) has in place a target for the whole of the county to become carbon neutral by 2050 alongside building resilience to a two-degree rise in temperature.</p> <p>A Climate Change Strategy and Action Plan support these targets, with a focus on a number of key priority sectors such as transport, energy and residential homes.</p>
Objective & Description	<p>The Climate Change Scrutiny Panel have discussed the desire to better understand the County's approach to achieving carbon neutrality and building resilience.</p> <p>It is proposed that the Panel invite representatives of HCC to present to a future meeting and answer questions (max. 30 minutes)</p> <p>Objectives would be to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Receive a top level overview of the County's Climate Change Strategy and Action Plan. 2) Understand the County's key priority sectors, with a particular focus on projects linked to residential, transport and energy emissions reductions and resilience building. 3) Identify opportunities for Fareham Council to work in partnership with HCC.
