

THE BOROUGH OF FAREHAM (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 5) REVOCATION ORDER 2013

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Fareham Borough Council propose to make the above named Order pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 with Hampshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 84, 85 and 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- 1 The effects of the Order will be to revoke The Borough of Fareham (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 5) Consolidation Order 2013, which extended the Bath Lane Car Park into land adjacent to the existing car park.
 - As such, the Bath Lane Car Park will revert to the area as designated by The Borough of Fareham (Off-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2007.
- A copy of the proposed Order and Order to be revoked, together with a statement of reasons for proposing to make the order, may be inspected at the office of the Head of Community Safety and Enforcement at the Civic Offices, Civic Way, Fareham, during usual office hours.
