1. MINUTES

RESOLVED that, the minutes of the meeting of the Joint Management Committee held on 12 January 2009, be confirmed and signed as a correct record, subject to the inclusion of the tables detailing the breakdown of visitor figures across the Museum service, attached to these minutes as Appendix B and Appendix C (fm-090112-m).

2. WESTBURY MANOR MUSEUM - PROGRESS AND DEVELOPMENT REPORT AND EDUCATION UPDATE

The Joint Management Committee considered a report by Thomas de Wit, Community Curator providing an update on the general progress and performance of the Museum and an additional report by Emma Hart, Education Officer which provided a summary of Schools Education to date (copy of report fm-090325-education-update appended to signed minutes).

Emma Hart, Education Officer reported on the current work in progress that had been completed to date in 2009, together with the forthcoming projects and work to be

undertaken.

Following the discussion of this item members' of the Committee were invited to take part in a 'hands on' activity session that was provided when local schools visit the Museum. There were three educational elements to the session involving census records, objects and photographs and members' were split into groups to look at each of the elements available to groups visiting the Museum.

(a) Events Programme

It was reported that since the last meeting of the Committee the Museum had held numerous events, as listed below.

- 1970s Car Show
- The Love Bug Half Term Craft Activity
- Gordon Keeble Hampshire's Supercar and Keeble K3, Fareham's Supercar

All had proved to be a great success throughout January to March, particularly the Gordon Keeble event which had attracted approximately 800 people over the two weekends it took place.

Forthcoming events at Westbury Manor Museum over the coming months included:-

- The Lost Archives Treasure Map, Archaeology and Mystery Maze Making Day
- Fareham Photograph History Day
- Treasure Hunter's Heiroglyphics Mystery Trail and Explorer's Activities
- Fabric Fashions Craft Workshop

(b) Exhibitions Programme

It was reported that since the last meeting of the Committee the Museum had held numerous exhibitions, as listed below:-

- The 1970's....the Decade that taste forgot?
- Raiders of the Lost Archives The Lost Photographs of Fareham (currently running in the Museum at the time of the meeting)

This exhibit uses modern technology to make the collection of photographs accessible to a wide audience. Using nine LCD and Plasma flat screens providing running video presentations and an interactive computer featuring the archive available, the exhibit makes the best possible use of all of the photographs and information kept to enable members of the public to record recollections, provide their own photographic data for inclusion or information about the photographs already available.

Alongside the photographs there was a fabulous display of cameras from the collection held by the County Museum Service to give the public an idea of the equipment used to produce the archive.

The Raiders of the Lost Archives exhibit had been very well received and utilised by the public today and had been covered by 'The News' in an illustrated feature.

Following discussion Members' of the Committee had a look at this exhibit held in the Museum Gallery.

Forthcoming exhibitions at Westbury Manor Museum over the coming months included:-

- Fabric of a Nation Textiles and Identity in Modern Ghana
- Myths and Legends

(c) Pride of Place

It was noted that the Pride of Place was currently displaying memorabilia ran in conjunction with the Gordon Keeble event. Recent exhibits had included a 4ft model of the Spinnaker Tower made from by a local man using matchsticks. Forthcoming displays would include the Fareham Model Engineering Society, celebrating 40 years and the Fareham Tourist Information Centre who were celebrating 25 years of service in the Borough.

(d) Recent Developments and Future Plans

The following recent development and future plans for the Museum were noted:-

- The provision to display a collection of original Ladybird books for visitors to the Museum on the Fareham Book Bus - this bookshelf was modelled on an old Provincial bus No. 55, the local bus was stationed in Fareham during World War 2 and is ran regularly in conjunction with Museum trips for local people. It was reported Westbury Manor Museum would be planning a trip on this bus along Portsdown Hill in August).
- In connection with the photographic exhibition 'Raiders of the Lost Archives', an archive of photographs had been given to the Museum by the Provincial Society which shows images of the local company over the last 70 years.
- The outreach work with Rivendale NHS Centre for adults with psychological and learning difficulties remained successful with trips planned to numerous sites including Fort Nelson, Portchester Castle and the D-Day relics on the Hamble
- A programme to create a new permanent display to reflect Fareham's key role on the global story of the development of speed in aviation and marine technology is being progressed.

(e) Visitor Figures

It was reported that visits to the end of 2008 were **32,969**, this figure had been the best recorded since 2004 and so far this year figures have indicated the best January on record. It was thought this was due to the success and press coverage of the 1970's event, giving January and February a visitor figure of 6146. A table of visitor numbers is shown below:-
