(h) Education Report

The Community Curator provided the Committee with an update on the provision of the Education Service from March to June 2010 and gave an update on future funding for the post of Education Officer.

Current work in progress and/or completed included among others:-

Led Sessions

- Free Key Stage 2 Minibeast Roadshow Sessions ran in April 2010 with a total of 280 children taking part.
- Free Hungry Caterpillar Bugs and Butterflies Sessions were offered Key Stage 1 classes at local schools. 282 children attended.
- Art-themed Session trialled called 'Inspiring Objects' with children at Redbarn Primary School.

- Year 6 Curator Training at Redbarn Primary School for four pupils.
- Development of a new 'Our Town in the Past' Session was created based on 1960's Portchester with the involvement of regular museum visitor and Portchester Community member, Chris Goodall who will be helping with future sessions.

Self Led Sessions

- Free Key Stage 2 resources used with 3 schools and 1 guide group in May/June 2010.
- Pupils from Wykeham House School visited Westbury Manor to participate in free Key Stage 1 self-led resources that had previously been developed by the Education Officer.
- Four gifted and talented pupils from Redbarn took part in a self led visit in June 2010 to find out about the museum and produced museum leaflets.

Several outreach sessions also took place during March to June 2010.

RESOLVED that:-

- (a) the reports be received and noted; and
- (b) the Community Curator and the Education Officer be thanked for their work undertaken.

3. SERVICE PLAN 2010/11

The Committee received a verbal update from officers regarding the draft Service Plan for 2010/11, which was circulated to members at the meeting and appended to signed minutes (<u>fm-100701- draft service plan 2010-11</u>).
