To consider the confirmation, subject to the proposed modification, of the following Fareham Tree Preservation Order which has been made by officers under delegated powers and to which no formal objection has been received:-

(i) FTPO 666 – Barton Copse, west of Alan Grove, Fareham

Order made on 7 December 2011 covering one woodland comprising oak, ash, field maple, hazel, hawthorn, holly, crab apple, cherry and birch.

It is recommended that Fareham Tree Preservation Order No. 666 be confirmed with modification to the northeast corner boundary of W1 on the plan, following correspondence with the owners at 59, Oak Road and 12 Alan Grove.

Members are asked to note that if the Committee resolve to confirm Fareham Tree Preservation Order No 630, then it is requested that Fareham Tree Preservation Order No 45 be revoked as all the trees contained in the older Order have, where appropriate, been included in the new Order.
