Ken Dimmer, Head Coach of Fareham School of Gymnastics has requested £4,969.60 to assist with the purchase of new equipment which is required due to an increase in membership levels.

The equipment the club are wishing to purchase includes a new balance beam and covers, roll mats, Evo flooring (foam based running strip), 3 x foam springboards and 3 x safety crash mats.
