Purpose:

This report presents an application for funding under the Council's Community Fund Programme.

An application for funding has been received from Mr Les Barnes, Club Welfare Officer of Crofton Judo Club, for the sum of £4,903.20 to purchase new judo mats for the club.

Crofton Judo Club is a family orientated club providing judo coaching at all levels and gives all members a chance to have fun at the same time as learning an Olympic sport. The club is open to all and due to an increased interest the club has moved to Titchfield Community Centre to accommodate new membership. The club regularly provides taster sessions and displays at community events.

The new mats will replace current ones that are 12 years old and are suffering from some wear and tear and are now becoming unsafe for use. Replacements are needed to help with the growing demand for membership.

RESOLVED that the application for £4,903.20 from Fareham Borough Council's Community Funding Programme, submitted by Mr Barnes of Crofton Judo Club for the purchase of judo mats, be approved, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Crofton Judo Club must submit to Fareham Borough Council, the original receipts for a previous grant of £4,787.94 awarded on 2 December 2013, and also a full set of accounts, prior to the payment of £4,903.20 being made; and
- (b) Crofton Judo Club must submit to Fareham Borough Council, receipts for the mats when they have been purchased.
