**Purpose:**

To consider revisions to the areas of executive responsibility for 2022-23 to Executive Members.

The Council's Standing Orders with respect to Meetings allows the Executive Leader to determine the areas of executive responsibility and to discharge Executive functions in accordance with S9E Local Government Act 2000 (SO 31& 32).

The Executive Leader therefore give notice that he intends to implement the following revisions from 12 May 2022:

- a) The areas of responsibility for the functions within portfolios to be added/removed as follows:
  - i. Street Naming and Numbering to be removed from the Planning and Development portfolio and added to the Health and Public Protection Portfolio;
  - ii. Town Centre Regeneration to be added to the Policy and Resources Portfolio;
  - iii. Sports Development, Leisure Card and Community Volunteering to be removed from the Leisure and Community Portfolio;
  - iv. Local Land Charges to be removed from the Housing Portfolio and added to the Health and Public Protection Portfolio;
  - v. NHS Liaison be added to the Health and Public Protection Portfolio;
  - vi. ICT and Personnel; Performance Management and Equalities to be removed from the Health and Public Protection Portfolio and added to the Policy and Resources Portfolio; and

vii. Play Area – Maintenance to be removed from the Streetscene Portfolio.

b) The areas of responsibility for the functions of Commercial Acquisitions, Sustainability and Biodiversity, Ferneham Hall and New Play Areas to be renamed as set out in Appendix B to this report.

**Options Considered:**

The Deputy Executive Leader was asked to consider some further amendments to those set out in the published report and these were:

- i. Remove Environmental Impacts and add Biodiversity to the Planning and Development Portfolio;
- ii. Add Food Safety to the Health and Public Protection Portfolio; and
- iii. Add Youth Activity Funding and Community Service Level Agreements to the Leisure and Community Portfolio.

It is recommended that the Deputy Executive Leader approves the amendments to the Executive portfolios as set out in Appendix B to the report, including the amendments listed above.
