#### 2. MINUTES

#### 3. CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Chairman requested that her thanks be put on record to Ian Rickman and the Licensing Team which have delivered significant cost savings over the years through the Fareham and Gosport Environmental Health Partnership. They are a small team, dedicated to the work that they do and are always very helpful.

#### 4. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest made at this meeting.

#### 5. DEPUTATIONS

There were no deputations made at this meeting.

#### 6. ACTUAL REVENUE EXPENDITURE 2022/23

The Committee considered a report by the Assistant Chief Executive Officer which provided details of actual revenue expenditure for 2022/23 in respect of the services for which the committee is responsible.

The variation in the hackney carriage and private hire vehicles budget was noted. Officers explained that this budget can be hard to predict as it is dependent on taxi drivers deciding whether to apply for 1, 3 or 5 year licences which carry different levels of fees.

RESOLVED that the Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Committee notes the content of the report.

#### 7. SPENDING PLANS 2024/25

The Committee considered a report by the Assistant Chief Executive Officer which sets out the Committee's spending plans for 2024/25.

In considering this item, a query was raised regarding the inclusion of costs involved in the next general election as it is known that this must take place in the 2024/25 financial year. Officers confirmed that these costs will be taken into account in the 2024/25 Revised Budget review.

A correction at paragraph 17 of the report was noted in that the decrease in the Licensing budget is partly attributable due to a <u>decrease</u> in partnership costs and not an increase (as stated).

RESOLVED that the Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Committee:

- (a) agrees the revised budget for 2023/24 as set out in the report;
- (b) agrees the base budgets for 2024/25, as set out in the report; and
- (c) recommends the budget to full Council for approval.

#### 8. FEES AND CHARGES 2024/25

The Committee considered a report by the Assistant Chief Executive Officer which sets out the proposed level of Fees and Charges for the Committee's services for 2024/25.

During the discussion on this item it was noted that the discretionary Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licence fees are low in comparison to some of the other local councils and that in addition, no increase has been suggested for this year. Officers explained that first and foremost, the Council cannot make a profit out of taxi licensing. In addition, there is disparity in what the different local Council's include in their fee. For example, Fareham makes separate charges for other elements of the licencing process whilst some other Council's charge an inclusive fee.

RESOLVED that the Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Committee:

- (a) agrees the Fees and Charges for 2024/25 as set out in the report; and
- (b) recommends the Fees and Charges to full Council for approval.

#### 9. PRELIMINARY REVIEW OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE PROGRAMME 2023/24 AND DRAFT WORK PROGRAMME 2024/25

The Committee considered a report by the Head of Environmental Health which invited members to carry out a preliminary review of the Committee's Work Programme for 2023/24 and a review of the draft Work Programme for 2024/25.

It was noted that, following the all-out local elections in May, it is likely that there will be new members on the Committee in the new municipal year. It will therefore be necessary to ensure training is organised. The Chairman took the opportunity to remind members of the importance of all members of the committee attending licensing training every year so that they are able to sit on Licensing Panels when called upon to do so.

It was suggested that the item scheduled for the meeting on 12 March 2024 should be entitled 'Statutory Review of <u>Local and</u> Parliamentary Polling Districts and Polling Places' so that members were also updated on any final changes to the local election arrangements. The Chairman advised that she felt that there would be sufficient time to do a full round up at the March meeting, but that, for the time being, the title of the item be left unchanged.

#### 1. LICENSING ACT 2003 - APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE AT TITCHFIELD FESTIVAL THEATRE, 73 ST MARGARET'S LANE, TITCHFIELD, FAREHAM PO14 4BG

The Panel had before it a report by the Licensing Officer and supplementary information provided by the Interested parties in respect of a variation to the premises licence at Titchfield Festival Theatre, 73 St Margaret's Lane, Titchfield, Fareham, PO14 4BG. The report contained the procedure for the hearing and advised members of the Panel of the representations made by Interested Parties. The report and supplementary information were made available in advance of the meeting to Panel Members, the Applicant and all Interested Parties that had made representations.

The application was heard in accordance with the Council's agreed procedure for hearings by the Licensing Panel and was considered as follows:

- (i) The Licensing Officer presented a summary of the application and of the representations received.
- (ii) The Applicant was invited to comment on the application as detailed by the Licensing Officer.
- (iii) Interested Parties were invited to ask questions of the Licensing Officer and seek points for clarification.
- (iv) Members of the Panel were invited to ask questions of the Licensing Officer and seek points for clarification.
- (v) The Applicant was invited to present their case and did so accordingly.
- (vi) Interested Parties were invited to ask questions of the Applicant and seek points for clarification.
- (vii) Members of the Panel were invited to ask questions of the Applicant and seek points for clarification and did so accordingly.
- (viii) At the invitation of the Chairman, the Council's Legal Advisor sought clarification from the Applicant on the maximum capacity of the premises.
- (ix) The Interested Parties were invited in turn to present their objections and did so accordingly.

- (x) The Applicant was invited to ask questions of the Interested Parties and seek points for clarification.
- (xi) Members of the Panel were invited to ask questions of the Interested Parties and seek points for clarification.
- (xii) The Licensing Officer was invited to ask questions of the Interested Parties and seek points for clarification.
- (xiii) The Licensing Officer was invited to present a final summary of the application.
- (xiv) The Applicant was invited to present a final summary of the application and did so accordingly.
- (xv) The Interested Parties were invited to present a final summary of their objections and did so accordingly.

The Chairman thanked the participants for attending the hearing and advised that the Panel would retire to consider their decision in private and would circulate the decision to all parties in due course.

#### DECISION OF THE LICENSING PANEL REGARDING THE APPLICATION MADE BY MR KEVIN FRASER FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE AT TITCHFIELD FESTIVAL THEATRE, 73 ST MARGARET'S LANE, TITCHFIELD, FAREHAM PO14 4BG

All parties shall receive written notification of the decision and reasons.

The Sub-Committee has considered very carefully the application for variation of the premises licence at Titchfield Festival Theatre, 73 St Margaret's Lane, Titchfield, Fareham PO14 4BG.

It has given due regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the Licensing Objectives, statutory guidance and the adopted statement of Licensing Policy. The Human Rights Act 1998, the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 and the Equality Act 2010 were borne in mind whilst making the decision.

The Sub-Committee noted that representations objecting to the application had been made by a number of local residents. No responsible authority, including the police, had made representations.

It has paid due regard to all representations and evidence both written and given orally today and attached due weight accordingly in light of all the circumstances.

Having heard all the evidence, the Panel has determined to grant the licence as set out in the application.

#### <u>REASONS</u>

The Panel was considering a variation to an existing licence and therefore only the variation was to be considered and not the existing licence. The variation did not seek to change any of the existing licensable activities but sought to extend the licensable area.

The objectors raised legitimate concerns around the parking situation and some noise, but these exist now irrespective of the application to vary the licence. The panel has to decide whether the issues arising fall under the remit of the Licensing Objectives and if so whether this application is going to adversely impact on those Objectives.

The Panel noted that no responsible authority had raised objection and the Panel is therefore bound to infer that the responsible authorities are satisfied with the application. The Statutory Guidance tells the Panel that the Responsible Authorities are deemed to be experts in their respective fields. In this case Environmental Health has not raised any issues regarding noise and the police have raised no objections around road safety or anti-social behaviour.

The Panel was reminded that the legislation and guidance are clear that there is a presumption of grant of an application unless objections cannot be met by conditions.

In this case the Panel is of the view that the issue around noise and parking arise not out of the premises having a licence but out of the extension of the capacity of the theatre. If this application were not granted those problems which exist now would persist. The Panel does not believe that granting this application will increase the numbers attending the venue and therefore will not make the current situation worse. In those circumstances the Legislation and Guidance is quite clear and gives the Panel very little scope other than to grant the licence.

Residents should take comfort from the strong powers on review set out in the Licensing Act 2003 and other measures under other legislation which exist to take enforcement action with regards to the premises licence where relevant. Reviews may be commenced by responsible authorities or residents. In this regard, should issues arise due to the premises not being run in the manner asserted by the Applicant during the hearing there are means of addressing this in future.

There is a right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court for all parties and formal written notification of the decision will set out that right in full.

#### 1. LICENSING ACT 2003 - APPLICATION FOR PREMISES LICENCE AT THE BOAT HOUSE CAFE, SWANWICK MARINA, SHORE ROAD, SWANWICK SO31 1ZL

The Panel had before it a report by the Licensing Officer and supplementary information provided by Interested Parties in respect of a premises licence at The Boat House Café, Swanwick Marina, Shore Road, Swanwick S031 1ZL.

The report contained the procedure for the hearing and advised members of the Panel of the representations made by Interested Parties. The report and supplementary information were made available in advance of the meeting to Panel Members, the Applicant and all Interested Parties that had made representations.

The application was heard in accordance with the Council's agreed procedure for hearings by the Licensing Panel and was considered as follows:

- (i) The Licensing Officer presented a summary of the application and of the representations received. It was clarified that the name of the premises is The Boat House Pop Up Café.
- (ii) The Chairman invited comments and points for clarification from the Applicant on the application, as submitted by the Licensing Officer. None were put forward.
- (iii) The Chairman invited comments and points for clarification from Members of the Panel on the application, as submitted by the Licensing Officer.
- (iv) The Applicant was invited to present their case and did so accordingly.
- (v) Members of the Panel were invited to ask questions of the Applicant and seek points for clarification.
- (vi) The Licensing Officer was invited to comment on points raised by the Panel Members and provided clarification accordingly.
- (vii) At the invitation of the Chairman, the Council's Legal Advisor addressed the meeting to give general advice in respect of the granting of a licence.
- (viii) The Applicant was invited to make a closing statement and did so accordingly.

The Panel then withdrew from the meeting to make their deliberations.

On completion of their deliberations, the Panel Members returned to the meeting, whereupon the Chairman announced the decision of the Panel as follows:

#### 28 February 2024 – Licensing Sub-Committee Decision Application for a Premises Licence – Premier Marinas, The Boat House Café, Swanwick Marina, Swanwick SO31 1ZL

All parties shall receive written notification of the decision and reasons.

The Sub-Committee has considered very carefully the application for a premises licence at The Boat House Café, Swanwick Marina, Swanwick SO31 1ZL.

It has given due regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the Licensing Objectives, statutory guidance and the adopted statement of Licensing Policy. The Human Rights Act 1998, the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 and the Equality Act 2010 were borne in mind whilst making the decision.

The Sub-Committee noted that following discussions with the police the application was varied so that the hours now sought are :

Sale of alcohol every day between 07:30 and 23:00 Recorded Music every day between 09:00 and 23:00 Live Music every day between 12 Noon and 23:00

The Sub-Committee noted that representations objecting to the application had been made by a number of local residents. No responsible authority, including the police and environmental health, had made representations.

It has paid due regard to all representations and evidence both written and given orally today and attached due weight accordingly in light of all the circumstances.

Having heard all the evidence, the Panel has determined to grant the licence with the revised hours as mentioned above.

#### <u>REASONS</u>

The objectors raised legitimate concerns around noise issues but many of these referred to the terminal hour of 1:00 am in the original application. None of the objectors attended the hearing. There was no representation from environmental health regarding noise issues. The Sub-Committee was reminded that the statutory guidance states that the responsible authorities are to be regarded as experts in their field.

The applicant stated that the premises is predominantly food led and the music, live and/or recorded will be of a background nature to accompany dining or an event. It will not be a nightclub and there will be no alcohol or music events. Additionally, there will be no flashing or disco lights at the premises.

The Sub-Committee was reminded of the exemptions in relation to live and recorded music so that no licence is required for :

Unamplified live music between 08:00 and 23:00 on any premises

Amplified live music between 08:00 and 23:00 in a workplace not authorised to sell alcohol.

Both of these exemptions apply to these premises whether a licence is granted or not. The granting of a licence would allow recorded and amplified live music between 08:00 and 23:00 and therefore has little impact on the concerns raised.

The Sub-Committee was reminded that the legislation and guidance are clear that there is a presumption of grant of an application unless objections cannot be met by conditions. In this case the reduced hours take the music outside of the licensing regime.

Residents should take comfort from the strong powers on review set out in the Licensing Act 2003 and other measures under other legislation which exist to take enforcement action with regards to the premises licence where relevant. Reviews may be commenced by responsible authorities or residents. In this regard, should issues arise due to the premises not being run in the manner asserted by the Applicant during the hearing there are means of addressing this in future.

There is a right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court for all parties and formal written notification of the decision will set out that right in full.

RESOLVED that the application for premises licence be granted.

Subject: STATUTORY REVIEW OF PARLIAMENTARY POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

#### SUMMARY

The Council has a statutory duty to keep under review the polling districts and polling places it uses for parliamentary (and other) elections. The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 requires that a review be undertaken before 31 January 2025. This report explains the process and puts forward proposals which may be incorporated into a draft scheme for consultation.

The Committee is now requested to consider the proposals set out in this report which will then be published for consultation before coming back to the committee for final consideration and recommendation to Council for the scheme to be approved.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Committee:

- (a) agrees the statutory notice, as set out in Appendix A to the report, and the timeline for the statutory review;
- (b) considers the proposed scheme of polling places as set out in Appendix B to the report; and
- (c) delegates authority to the Assistant Director (Democracy), following consultation with the Chairman of the Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Committee and the Returning Officer, to make any minor amendments to the proposed timeline in order to meet the statutory review in the event of the UK Parliamentary General Election being called before the review is completed.

#### INTRODUCTION

- 1. In accordance with the Electoral Administration Act 2006, the Council has a statutory duty to keep under review the polling districts and polling places it uses for parliamentary (and other) elections. The last full review was completed in 2019 and an interim review was undertaken in 2023 to address the new warding arrangements implemented following the Electoral Review of Fareham carried out by the Local Government Boundary Commission.
- 2. The regulations contained in The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 introduced a change to the timing of compulsory reviews of UK Parliamentary polling districts and places. The current compulsory review must now be started and completed between October 2023 and 31 January 2025.
- 3. The Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Committee (LRA) has delegated powers to undertake such a review and to recommend a final scheme to the Council for adoption.
- 4. This report outlines the process for the 2024 review, explains what has been done so far and invites the LRA Committee to approve draft proposals for further consultation. The LRA Committee will be asked at its next meeting to consider any further comments received and to recommend a final scheme for adoption by Council for the next four years.

#### THE LEGISLATIVE BACKGROUND

- 5. The Representation of the People Act 1983 requires the local authority to divide its area into polling districts for the purpose of parliamentary elections and to keep such districts under review. Polling districts may also be designated for local government elections and in practice they follow the same boundaries as the parliamentary ones.
- 6. Essentially, polling districts are the geographical sub-divisions of an electoral area, whether that is a constituency, a county division or a borough ward. Neither the parliamentary constituency boundaries, nor the local government wards and division boundaries may be changed by this process.
- 7. A local authority is also required to designate a polling place for each polling district. A polling place is a building or an area in which polling stations are located. The location of a polling station within a polling place is a matter for the Returning Officer and, as part of this review, the Returning Officer is required to make formal comment on polling stations currently or likely to be used in any parliamentary (or other) election.
- 8. In undertaking a review, the local authority must seek to ensure that all electors in a constituency have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances. It must also seek to ensure that so far as is practicable every polling station is accessible to electors who are disabled. A polling place should preferably be located within the polling district, but the Act recognises this is not always feasible,
- 9. The process for undertaking a review is largely prescribed by the Act and regulations but minor alterations can be implemented between major reviews to satisfy the reasonable requirements of electors or to consider the accessibility to disabled persons of polling stations within a designated polling place.
- 10. If the local authority in carrying out a review fails to meet the reasonable requirements

of the electors or does not take sufficient account of the accessibility to disabled persons of polling stations within a designated polling place, then representations may be made to the Electoral Commission. The Commission may then direct the authority to make alterations to the polling places designated in the review.

#### THE 2024 REVIEW

- 11. The review is being conducted in three stages in order to give maximum opportunity for public comment and the views of local interest groups to inform the review:
  - Stage One: (1 October 2023 2 May 2024) Give notice of the review; commence inspection of current and potential polling places as necessary; prepare draft proposals.
  - Stage Two: (6 May 2024 3 June 2024) Publish draft proposals as determined by the LRA Committee at the meeting of 12 March 2024; invite comment from interested parties and statutory consultees; complete inspection of current and potential polling places as necessary.
  - Stage Three: (24 June 2024 26 July 2024) The LRA Committee at its July meeting to consider comments received and recommend a final scheme to Council; adoption of the final scheme; public notice given; Electoral Registration Officer to implement and publish register of electors on 1 September 2024. Returning Officer to have regard to the scheme in the conduct of elections.
- 12. Stage one is partially complete with the inspection of current and potential polling places completed as part of the Electoral Review implementation. Subject to the agreement of the LRA Committee, the Notice of Review will be published on 18 March 2024 (attached as Appendix A). Officers have also sought expert advice on accessibility, as required in the legislation and consulted with local accessibility groups.
- 13. The review now prepares to move to stage two, with a draft scheme presented to the LRA Committee which is to be published for further consultation immediately following the Local Elections in May 2024.

#### THE DRAFT SCHEME

- 14. Attached to this report at Appendix B is the detail of newly arranged polling districts for each ward, following completion of the Local Government Boundary Commission Electoral Review.
- 15. The recently completed Electoral Review resulted in new warding arrangements being adopted across the Borough and these new arrangements officially come into force at the Local Elections in May 2024.
- 16. The Electoral register published on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2023 adopted the new warding arrangements following an interim review of polling districts and polling places reported to this committee on 5 October 2023.
- 17. Any apparent inequalities in the electorate totals for each polling district is due to the conflicting County and/or Parliamentary boundaries which in some cases carve

through the Fareham wards.

18. As a reminder, the new warding arrangements resulted in changes to the names, layout and electorate of wards across the Borough. There are now 32 wards with the following elector number prefix references and ward names:

19. Members are asked to consider the draft proposals of polling districts and their assigned polling places, as set out in Appendix B, which will be published as a draft scheme for statutory consultation as part of Stage 2 of the review (as set out in paragraph 11 above).

#### **RISK ASSESSMENT**

20. The LRA Committee is reminded that undertaking this review fulfils the Council's statutory obligations, However, failure to meet the reasonable requirements of electors or not taking sufficient account of accessibility to disabled persons may lead to representations to the Electoral Commission who may direct changes to be made. In undertaking the review the Council may ensure that it is taking reasonable steps to enable all electors to participate in the democratic process.

#### CONCLUSION

21. The Council is required to undertake a review of the polling districts and places used in parliamentary (and other) elections before 31 January 2025. It must observe certain criteria, not least of which is accessibility to polling places by disabled persons. The draft proposals set out in Appendix B to this report have been formed taking account of the recently completed Electoral Review of the Borough including the interim review of polling districts and polling places. The LRA Committee is asked to approve a draft proposal, which will proceed to public consultation. Any comments received will be brought back to the Committee at its next meeting, with a view to recommending a final scheme to Council for adoption.
