Site Description

The application relates to an existing telecommunications mast sited north-east of Spring Road in Park Gate. The mast is mainly visible from the motorway as when viewed from Spring Road it is screened behind trees. The top element of the mast can be seen from the northernmost part of Addison Road.

Description of Proposal

It is proposed to install:

- -two VHF dipole antennas to the top of the existing mast at a mean height of 24m,
- -a 300mm diameter dish antenna to the mast at 15m to the centre of dish,
- -a ground base 2.7m x 2.7m x 2.7m equipment cabin on a new concrete base, and
- -two GPS antennas, overhead cable gantry and support poles.

Representations

No representation have been received as a result of publicising the application.

Planning Considerations - Key Issues

The application site is outside of the defined settlement boundary as indicated on the inset map of the Local Plan.

The site is surrounded by grassland and trees. The trees provide a good level of screening/backdrop to the existing equipment. Views of the mast from neighbouring properties are limited and there is a good degree of separation. Therefore it is not considered that its visual impact would be significant on the local landscape.

The proposal also accords with the requirements of the Policy DSP55: Telecomunications in that:

- i. there will be no significant adverse effect on the external appearance of the space in which, equipment is to be located;
- ii. there will be no significant adverse impact on the visual amenity of one or more neighbouring occupiers or heritage assets;
- iii. the proposal is to add onto existing equipment;
- iv. the equipment will be to a great extent camouflaged within existing trees;
- v. equipment is appropriately designed, coloured and landscaped taking account of its setting.

It is noted that the applicant has completed, as part of the submission, the declaration that

the installation will be in compliance with the guidelines of the International Commission on Non-Ionising Radiation (ICNIRP).

CONCLUSION:

The proposal is considered to be acceptable and as such it is recommended that permission be granted.

Recommendation


PERMISSION subject to conditions:
