Subject: ESTATE IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAMME 2013/14

SUMMARY

This report provides Board members with information on schemes suggested for inclusion in the programme of Estate Improvements for 2013-14.

The report also provides Board members with an update on the schemes approved for 2012-13.

RECOMMENDATION

That Board members note the information contained in the report, indicating their support for and endorsement of the schemes identified.

INTRODUCTION

- 1. A budget of £18,000 for 2013-14 has been set aside from the Housing Revenue Account (HRA) to fund a number of housing estate and environmental improvement schemes.
- 2. In recent months officers have sought suggestions for improvement schemes through tenant and leaseholder forum meetings and tenant and leaseholder discussion at estate inspections.
- 3. Details of suggested schemes together with estimated costs are shown below:-
