We have historically had many problems with people leaving the club swearing, being very ill and fighting in the street directly in front of our house, most recently last Sunday, I had to get out of bed and warn them that I would call the police if they didn't move on - this was at midnight. we know they had come from the club because their friends waiting for taxis were still shouting for them.

People waiting for taxis are also making a lot of noise late and the taxis themselves pulling up at late slamming doors etc. is a real problem. it makes you very nervous and upset that people are allowed to behave like this in a residential area.

The main problem isn't local people, it seems to be the guests attending celebrations.

We used to ring the police when fights broke out, but it doesn't seem to do any long term good, so now we just cross our fingers that they will move on quickly.
