**Representation on application for a variation licence under the licensing act 2003
Fareham Working Mens Club, Mill Road, Fareham, PO16 0TN**

Following our recent submission of representation expressing concerns to the above application, we wish to inform you of additional supporting information and facts as to why this application should NOT be granted.

For whatever reason, our names and details have been passed on to the Club, which has now caused a rather awkward and uncomfortable situation, particularly as we are members. The matter of our disapproval to the proposed application is being discussed with members of the club who are not on the committee and we have already been approached by a non committee member to try and dissuade us from pursuing our representation. We are also now concerned that there may be further repercussions to our objection. Our 'opened' letter was returned by the club with a note advising they will be holding a meeting on the 15th December for them to explain the club's licence amendment application but have yet to confirm a time. With such short notice, it is not possible to attend. This meeting has not been made public and everyone is still in the dark as to their intentions.

Our family have been residents of 4 Mill Road since the 1950's and have witnessed many an "incident" both inside and outside the club, spilling out into the residential area, which has resulted in police attendance. We are disappointed that as local residents, we were not approached directly by the Club, or Council, either prior to, or shortly after the application being submitted and due to the method of the notification process, left residents with little or no time to submit their objections. In addition, some residents did not lodge their disapproval in fear that it may affect their house prices at the point of selling, if they had had issues with neighbours.

As local residents, we have also been subject and witnesses to many issues and disregards of terms. Over the past weekend we have already seen our tree vandalised and an empty bottle of Vodka left outside our gates. Although there is a covered smoking/drinking area to the rear of the members


side of the club, there are no such facilities for patrons attending private functions in the Concert Hall. Therefore the badge accessible front doors are generally left open and guest use the front of the premises to smoke and drink. As I'm sure you can imagine, there can often be an overindulgence of alcohol and emotions run high - the results and aftermath are never pretty or polite. This kind of behaviour during the summer months means that children's bedroom windows can not be left open and the noise from the clubs air conditioning running through the night disturbs adults sleep. If you then add into the equation the fact that the clubs car park barriers are always left open, this encourages guests to hang about longer and make a nuisance with motor vehicles to the rear of the club into the early hours.


As already mentioned, we are long term members of the club and enjoy both the events and social aspects offered by the establishment, but as residents we do not approve of any change or extension to the licensing hours currently in place.

We look forward to hearing from you with regards to this matter and hope that the council support the local residents.


