# Consultation

- Consultation took place to help name the site
- Options were; Abbey Meadows, Meon Meadows and Tannery Meadows
- 2535 residents took part
- Name will be revealed at Full Council on 26 July



# Proposals for the site

The site will include:

- Orchard
- Wildflower meadow
- Educational wildlife area
- Footpaths
- Interpretations panels
- Seating, bins and a car park
- Play area



# A brand new play area

- Consultation will begin in September for residents to help choose equipment
- Working with local schools including special schools
- Online game for children and families to design their own play area



# Type of play area

- Natural wooden theme
- Suitable for all ages and abilities
- Car park close by
- Good links to the rest of the site
- No fencing
