Since our conversation I have checked again for other notices on or near the Sir Joseph Paxton site. I have found three which are also not prominent or readable. I hope it will be OK if I send photos of those with a second email to stay within the Outlook memory constraints.

Regarding the reason for my representation, this is the public nuisance and potential disturbance which would be suffered by the many hundreds of residents (including my household) within a few hundred metres radius of the subject pub, if music and/or extended beer garden hours are introduced.

**APPLICATION TO VARY A PREMISES LICENCE
LICENSING ACT 2003**

HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that an application has been submitted to the Council on 23rd July 2020 to vary a premises licence at Pond Road PO14 4PF:
