### YOUR COMMENTS ON THE CASE

In my view this proposed development is in the wrong place. The appeal does nothing to counter the congestion problem. Downend Road going North from the A27 is a slightly widened country lane unsuitable for heavy traffic. It narrows at the railway bridge before getting wider and, along the top, reverts to its country lane width. At rush hours and shortly before the queues to go onto the A27 or onto Downend Road are long. Adding the number of cars generated by 350 new houses will cause massive queues. The houses at the bottom of Downend Road do not allow road widening. As I said the proposed development is in the wrong place.
