Dear Mr Salter

The Portchester Civic Society continues to oppose this development.

We ask Inspectors to closely look at our previous comments of 11/10/2018, 12/11/2019 and 15/08/2020.

In addition to our previous comments on parking in local approach roads to the site, the current lockdowns have increased the number of people working from home. This results in additional on street parking during the working day that is expected to remain for many, who will continue to work from home even after lockdown ends.

We are very concerned about the loss of habitat for migrating Brent Geese. We note that Natural England still state that the proposals will result in a loss of supporting habitat, and they do not have certainty that the proposed mitigation will replicate the current ecological function of the site to offset this loss and protect the integrity of the designated sites.
