YOUR COMMENTS ON THE CASE

Dear Sir/Madam

Unfortunately I am unable to attend the public hearing due to work commitments but would like to once again implore Fareham Borough Council to reject this appeal as the subject of overcrowded schools, doctor's surgeries, dentists etc have still not been addressed by the developers. If 225 houses are built, that could mean a minimum of 450 more people needing NHS services, schools etc. Not to mention more cars on the road at peak times. The waiting list for nurseries and nursing homes is still growing and roads round here are getting more congested by the day. It has been made worse by the housing development at Cranleigh Road.

To use Romsey Avenue and Beaulieu Avenue (or any of the small roads round here) as access roads is ridiculous. They were never designed for so many vehicles and are far too narrow.

What about sewerage treatment, water, electricity, gas, waste collection services etc. Are there plans to increase them to meet additional demands?

We have so little open space left here now and with applications to build on Winham Farm and surrounding fields, traffic will soon be at a standstill.

The developers neither know or care about the local residents and should not be allowed to repeatedly appeal.

We have Wellbourne Village being built, which will add a substantial amount of housing plus all the small developments around the area (16 dwellings on the former open space on Portchester roundabout and flats being built over the old Co op shop are just two examples that springs to mind).

These developments, especially Wellbourne must surely cover the additional housing that the Government has instructed for the Fareham area, Why not use disused office and brown site spaces before encroaching on the countryside.

Wildlife too will suffer.

We pay very high (increasing) council tax bills and yet our quality of life is decreasing due to the greed of developers who don't even live in the area.

Please continue to support local residents and refuse this appeal once and for all.
