Good afternoon,

My response on this development is as follows:

This development lies within the catchment areas of Wicor Primary School and Cams Hill Secondary School. These schools are full.

The proximity of Wicor Primary School and the lack of local places indicates that an expansion of the school is likely to be required. On the assumption that all the 225 dwellings are 2 beds or more than this would yield (based on 0.3 children per dwelling) 67 primary age pupils. Based on the costs of a 0.5 form of entry (105 places) expansion then a contribution of £1,181,947. This contribution will contribute towards the provision of additional infrastructure at Wicor Primary School and should also be available to fund the undertaking of school travel plans and associated infrastructure such as additional cycle/scooter storage or improvements to sustainable travel routes.
