Annex 1

Mandatory Conditions

1 Licensing Act 2003 Section 19 - Supply of alcohol

Where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions:

that no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with operating schedule

Prevention of Crime and Disorder

2 Trained staff will carry out regular monitoring of all trade areas, with particular attention to the public conveniences.

3 All staff members shall be instructed to refer to the Designated Premises Supervisor in cases of doubt about age.

4 All inclusive nights or other irresponsible drinks promotions will not be permitted. 5 All external area, including the car park, shall be maintained with adequate illumination.

6 Customers will be encouraged to leave the premises in a quite and orderly manner 7 Staff will e trained to observe the measures necessary to promote the crime and disorder objective

8 A proof of age policy will operate in relation to relevant licensable activities

9 The premises will liaise and co-operate with the responsible authorities.

Public Safety

10 The existing fire safety precautions will be retained and maintained.

11 At least one personal licence holder at the premises will be a recognised first aider.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

12 No music or speech shall be relayed via external speakers.

13 Regular checks will be made outside the building to monitor noise levels emanating from the premises.

14 Deliveries and other activities from service providers will not take place before 07:00 hours.

15 The premises will be adequately ventilated to prevent nuisance.

16 The extract filters shall be cleaned on a regular basis to ensure kitchen odours are kept to a minimum.

17 Any noise from the licensable activities provided will be monitored in order to prevent nuisance.

The Protection of Children from Harm

18 Persons under the age of 16 should be accompanied at the premises at all times with a parent, guardian or responsible adult.

19 A proof of age policy will operate in relation to the relevant licensable activities.

20 Non-alcoholic drinks will be available

In addition those restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 apply where appropriate.

(NB The above conditions may relate to more than one objective.)

Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

21 The premises will be a member of any local Pubwatch that is in existence and will attend Pubwatch meetings.

22 At all times in the absence of the DPS or a personal licence holder a nominated duly authorised and suitably trained member of staff aged over 18 years old is to be present at all times the premises are open to the public.

23 Recordable CCTV to be of a standard and specification agreed by Police which may be acceptable for evidential use if required. The system must record the inside and outside of the premises.

24 All private functions shall be subject to a written risk assessment which will include the type of event and approximate number of people.

25 All external windows and doors will be closed by 22:30 except for access and egress when live or recorded music is being played.

26 Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.

27 Hampshire Police "Challenge 21" scheme should be adopted whereby all staff should should challenge anybody who looks under 21 years of age and only accept a UK passport, or UK driving licence, or PASS approved cards as proof of ID.

28 A "Challenge 21" poster should be displayed in a prominent position at the premises near ear bar/till area.

29 No person under the age of 16 should remain inside the premises after 22:30 with the exception of Christmas Eve and New Years Eve when they should at all times be in the company of a parent, guardian or responsible adult.
