Dear Pearl Gillies,

Thank you for your letter and enclosed information.

Unfortunately I won't be able to attend the hearing in person, as I am shielding, due to being the carer for an elderly relative who is immunocompromised.

As to the clarifications asked for :-

1. I would like to see conditions attached to the licence so that any loud entertainment would be indoors - not in the carpark - with noise cancelling measures in place.
2. To avoid a noise nuisance being created, I would like to see these measures put into action :-
 - No events to be held in the carpark.
 - All loud entertainment events to be held indoors
 - Noise cancelling design to be included, such as no hard reflective wall surfaces - those have been shown to increase noise.
 - Any noise-generating equipment to be sited away from corners of room.
 - Carpeting to be in place to dampen noise
 - Maximum decibel level on noise-generating equipment to be set.

3. Evidence of nuisance

I like to spend time outdoors in my garden, but on Saturday 3rd July, the noise from the pub music event was so loud that I had to go indoors and shut all windows and doors. This was a completely unreasonable level of noise in a residential area, particularly an area full of elderly people in bungalows.
