



The main grounds for this representation concerns the potential playing of amplified music, both live and recorded.

The Heathfield Arms is in a quiet residential area. Removal of the current licensing restrictions is totally unreasonable for this situation. The level of noise would be very detrimental to the health and well being of the local residents. Considerable stress would be caused to the mainly elderly inhabitants of the surrounding houses, bungalows and flats. It is unfair that they should not be able to use their outside space, and be forced to stay indoors with closed windows whenever amplified music is being played.

We are also concerned with the possible extended opening times, as this may lead to more noise and public nuisance at closing time. In addition, with the present reduced car park, there is potential for problems with customers parking in, already crowded surrounding roads.

On Saturday 3rd July 2021 the Heathfield Arms was granted a temporary events licence, which allowed amplified music to be played outside. We were given a taste of what life would be like if this application is approved. We have lodged a complaint concerning the noise level and made our local councilor, Tina Ellis, aware of the situation. The noise level was more suited to a pop festival, where it needed to cover very large area, rather than a quiet residential street. It was completely excessive for an audience crowded into a small car park.

Dear Sir,

I understand the Heathfield Arms has applied for a licence to play live music outside the premises, and also inside.

I have not seen anything in writing in respect of the application but only from social media, with all the misinformation that contains!!

If my assumptions are right, then I must express severe reservations about music being played outside, presumably in their new outside area.

As you can see I live only a short distance from the pub so well within earshot.

I would never object to music being played inside as that is attenuated by the building, but outside is a very different issue. There is nothing except distance to attenuate the noise. Additionally my elevation is above the line of the pub reducing/eliminating any attenuation by nearby buildings.

This will therefore seriously affect our quality of life every time they have either a band or recorded music . Assume there is no limit on the decibel levels produced nor means to monitor?

The licence does not to my knowledge limit the number of events in any time period, so it could be just once a month or very weekend or even every night. I must assume it does however state an end time of 2300 hours? How will that be enforced? By only responding to complaints? Or some other means unknown to me?

I am not a killjoy, but cannot see why they believe they have to play loud music to enjoy themselves.

It is of interest the landlords of the pub don't even live on the premises so can escape any issues resulting in the noise.

I have to strongly object to a poorly thought out idea

Dear Sir/madam

I wish to object to the application for varying of the premise license of the Heathfield Arms, Fareham.

I object to the pub being able to hold live music indoors and out and to being able to open later.

The reasons for my objections are this is a residential area and my concern is that this will increase the possibility for public nuisance and disturbance for neighbouring residents including myself and my young family.

On the occasions where they currently have events such as live music which was held on 3rd July, the noise was extremely excessive and could be heard in our property whilst windows and doors were shut.

On other occasions such as recently when the Euro Football was on, the noise was loud and anti social behaviour such as swearing could be heard inside the property whilst again windows and doors were shut. We have two children under 4 years old and the language and behaviour was not acceptable.

On the odd special occasion we accept that there will be some noise however if this is a regular occurrence this will make living there intolerable.

Another issue is the parking for events. When events are held the car park is not big enough for patrons and they park in Anjou Crescent, and frequently block drop curbs, making it impossible for residents to access their properties or park.

Based on the above points, please take my objection into consideration when considering the varying of the license.

This Post Code is a quiet, mostly bungalow, residential area. Most home owners are of an older age range who have moved to the Heathfield Estate because of the quiet nature of the area. It is not a suitable venue for amplified music to be performed outdoors at festival decibel levels - which they were on 3rd July. We could clearly hear the music from the car park with all windows + doors shut. The car park is now smaller due to the building work at the side of the pub, limiting parking spaces which would see visiting drinkers' parking spilling into other roads. Having amplified music inside the pub with the windows and doors open would result in the same level of noise pollution.

Please provide as much information as possible to support the representation (please read guidance note 2)

Mrs. Tina Ellis has a recording supplied by ourselves of the music from 3rd July which could be clearly heard above our phone ringing. I have personally phoned the pub in previous incidents to ask them to turn their music down as we could hear it with windows and doors shut.

When the pub has had a music licence previously, petty crimes were committed in the area e.g. garden walls being kicked over by late night departees. Outside noise levels in general are not monitored or controlled e.g. huge noise straight after lockdown with overcrowding of marquee and loud singing which could be clearly heard. I have previously phoned the licensing department a few months ago to report amplified music being played outside which was not covered by their licence.

I moved to this part of Fareham, because it is a quiet, residential area, with mostly elderly people in bungalows. I liked the idea of peace and quiet and neighbours who were unlikely to be holding loud parties or the like.

However, I was horrified to learn a few days ago of plans by the pub to hold loud entertainment events in their car park.

This type of loud entertainment in a carpark would be understandable in a venue far away from town, but it is completely inappropriate in a very quiet residential area full of elderly people.

If they were planning to hold their entertainment indoors, where noise-cancelling measures could be put in place, that would be more reasonable. But loud entertainment in a carpark will cause a public nuisance to people living in the vicinity of the Deathfield Arms.

We moved into 86 Abbey road this year and before doing so looked into the license held by The Heathfield Arms to check what has now been requested wasn't allowed. Since moving in we have had no issues with general noise from the pub other than one off due to patrons leaving, but nothing too much to complain about.

We believe that if the proposed licensing restrictions are removed then it will significantly affect ourselves and the local neighbourhood in terms of public nuisance. My partner works shifts and weekends so we value highly the ability to sleep without high levels of noise. We object to allowing external windows and doors to be open past 11:30 as we feel this is a reasonable time to already to close them to avoid any public nuisance issues. We ~~have~~ ^{can} hear the pub at times when people are outside / windows + doors of the pub are open at the moment.

Our main objection is to the removal of condition 12. Recently the pub was granted a temporary removal of this condition for Saturday 3rd July and the noise generated was at an unacceptable level in both our house and garden. When sitting 2m apart in our garden we had to shout to hear each other, this made our garden unusable. The noise was also excessively loud inside the house with all windows and doors shut. We are not against the pub having live music at all and would be happy for them to apply for temporary restriction removal a few times a year.

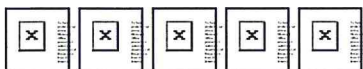

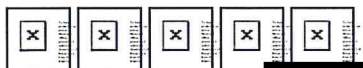

On a personal level I am in my mid seventies and look after a family member who has had a stroke, so I am up early and retire early - late night music would disrupt this.

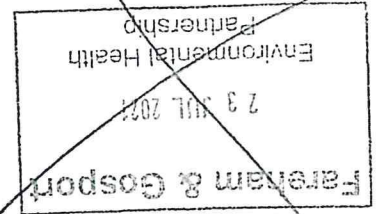
I also feel that longer opening hours would lead to rowdy behaviour and more litter.

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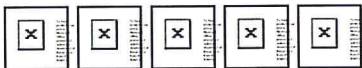

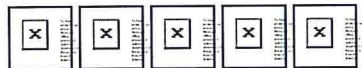

I live in the vicinity of the Heathfield Arms and understand that the licensee has applied for a licence for amplified music outside & other forms of entertainment and I am very concerned that this will cause considerable noise nuisance to me & the whole neighbourhood.

I live 3/4 houses back from the pub behind Dalewood Close & Anjou Crescent, far enough away, I thought, from the activities of the pub and other businesses.

I have lived here for 4 1/2 yrs and the area is generally very quiet which is important to me as I am disabled and quite housebound, so my peace is important to me. I think this is true of a number of people in the area.

In the time I have been here I have been disturbed by music from the pub on occasions but accepted this as it was not very often - maybe 2-3 times a year. However, the fact that a licence has been applied for specifying outside entertainment is a significant change from a family oriented pub that is busy in the afternoon and early evening, to one that attracts a different kind of patron, with more noise, bad behaviour & drunkenness and aggression.

I say this because I have lived in close proximity to a pub in a residential area before. They were granted an extended licence and there was loud music, loud TV football matches, loud amplified pub quizzes that could be heard all over the area.

with fights in the street, shouting till late at night from people waiting for taxis, and damage to property & vehicles. It made our lives a misery.

I am concerned that the licensee has already built a performance area in the car park, thus reducing the on site parking, and Blackbrook Rd is already difficult to navigate, with cars parked on both sides of the road, leading to weaving in and out and constant stop start driving to get to and from my home, even during the day.

It seems that this issue has already caused tension in the community, with strong feelings on both sides. However, I would point out that it is the residents who bear the brunt of other people's profit or 'fun'. Apparently the music on the last occasion could be heard in Oak Rd.

I just want to live peacefully in my own home.

I have no bad feelings toward the pub, but would ask that the 'having fun' that is referred to could be done without the whole neighbourhood having to be involved.

The landlady knew she was taking on a pub in a residential area when she moved here 14 yrs ago.

I am very worried that this idea could escalate nuisance, noise and disruption, spoiling the neighbourhood and reducing the saleability and value of our houses.

I wanted to extend and improve my home in the next 1-2 yrs but now I feel I should put this on hold

until I have clarity about whether I want to continue to live here or move (given my previous experience).

I am sure the landlady could find other ways of making up lost profit without doing something so disruptive. I believe we have been understanding of the level and frequency of the music to date.

I have had no wish to make representation before now

To be clear, I am objecting to any licence that allows music or entertainment outside as it is impossible to manage the intrusion and reach of noise nuisance in this circumstance.


I am not clear what binding limits on duration/frequency/noise levels (dbs)/review of impact are intended or in place and how residents would be involved in decision processes, as there has been no effort to inform us, much less ask our opinion, beyond the minimum requirements to date.
