Subject: 86 Abbey Road Clarifications - The Heathfield Arms premises license

Hi Pearl,

We received your correspondence regarding the application for a premises license by The Heathfield Arms.

We do not intend on attending the hearing in person.

Clarifications:

- 1) Would the hearings panel be able to attach conditions to the license which would satisfy your concerns in respect of any potential for crime and disorder and public nuisance.
- 2) If this were possible, could you identify the measures which would satisfy your concerns.

Our Answer:

We believe that if the license was limited in certain ways then our concerns could potentially be satisfied with regards to live music. One idea we had was to follow a very similar local pubs license which we know plays live music. I have since looked up the live music parts of the license for "The Crofton" in Hill Head as they seem similar in terms of location within a neighbourhood. They can play live music indoors only and have a limit of a number of 2 performers. This could potentially satisfy our concerns with regards to the live music part of the license.

We do not believe the part of the license referring to leaving windows open till 23:00 can be made satisfactory even with limitations added. However we don't know the full impact of this as whilst we have lived here it's not been till this late.

- 3) Have you any first hand evidence of incidents of crime and disorder and/or nuisance which has arisen as a result of the actions of patrons of the Heathfield Arms.
