What are you thinking of changing or implementing?

An updated Social and Affordable Housing Adaptation Policy has been produced, which will be implemented in November 2022.

The aim of the policy is to ensure that tenants with disabilities be provided with housing that best meets their assessed needs. This may be through adaption of their existing accommodation or by providing options for more suitable alternative housing.

This policy will also assist Occupational Therapists (OT) and other professionals to understand what adaptions can be made by the Council in its housing stock.

Since the last policy was approved in 2019 there have been revisions to legislation and statutory requirements. The draft Fareham Borough Council Social and Affordable Housing Adaptation Policy updates the existing document with reference to the new legislation and reflects the changes within the current Housing department structure. There is little change in the fundamental aspects of the policy, instead the procedures have been explained more clearly.

What is the expected or anticipated impact of this change?

The expected impact of the policy is that Fareham Borough Council tenant's will be able to receive the necessary adaptations needed for their home.

The changes to the policy will further improve the process for eligible Fareham Borough Council tenant's.
