OWNER OF THE TITCHFIELD FESTIVAL THEATRE HEARD OF OUR PLIGHT AND KINDLY OFFERED US THE USE OF AN AREA AT THE BACK OF THE EXISING THEATRE. THIS PROVED A BOON AND THE SHEDS MEMBERSHIP GREW FROM THE MID FORTIES AND NOW STANDS AT ALMOST 80. WE CATER FOR RECENTLY BEREAVED GENTLEMEN, THOSE WHO ARE LONELY AND IN NEED OF MALE COMPANIONSHIP AND THOSE WHO HAVE RECENTLY RETIRED AND FEEL THE NEED TO "KEEP BUSY".
