## YOUR COMMENTS ON THE CASE

I run a Meetup group for people over the age of 50. We regularly (and frequently) visit the TFT both as a group and as individuals. There is no other theatre locally bringing the diversity, quantity and quality of the TFT productions. The Kings Theatre and the New Theatre Royal in Portsmouth and the Ashcroft in Fareham produce a different, and often more costly type of theatre, the former being being mainly tribute acts, comedy or music the latter being much smaller. There is definitely a place for all of these venues and it would be a shame to close TFT without at least trying to accommodate it. Perhaps FBC could work with the theatre to overcome the parking problems and promote and support what is a well used and popular venue?
