(2) P/24/0712/FP Titchfield Common Ward

The following matter was not included within the considerations within the Committee Report:

Within the application, the section on Trees and Hedges, question one, has been marked as 'No'. The semi-mature Hawthorn tree, directly to the front of the house, is of a size and location to fall with the remit of BS 5837:2012 (Trees in relation to design, demolition and construction) and as such a full survey and report should have been submitted at the time of application. Although the tree is not significant in its own right, it is part of the original estates planting and contributes to the roads tree lined appeal.

Officers have considered the concern raised and whilst the tree is a nice feature within the street scene, it is modest size, unprotected tree and could be removed at any time without consent. The proposal does not include any ground works to be carried out close to the tree, which is already bounded by timber sleepers with the remainder of the front garden covered in slate chippings. Taking the above into account, it would be unreasonable and unnecessary to require a tree protection plan/condition in this case.
