This report presents an application for funding under the Council's Community Fund Programme.

Executive summary:

Louise McLean from 1st Titchfield Sea Scouts has requested funding of £4,100 to purchase tents and cooking equipment.

The Group are based in Titchfield Village and have an emphasis on having fun while helping young people learn life skills that will help them become valuable members of society. The new equipment will enable them to take approximately 50 young people to an annual jamboree this year and take part in activities like garden clearance for the elderly, Titchfield Carnival and various summer and winter camps.
