Purpose:

This report presents an application for funding under the Council's Community Fund Programme.

Executive Summary:

Mrs Joy Thornby, Trustee of Fareham Rifle and Pistol Club, has requested £3,200.00 to assist with the refurbishment of both the men's and ladies toilets to ensure that people with disabilities are able to access the facilities.

Fareham Rifle and Pistol Club have recently been appointed as the Southern Hub for Disabled Target Shooting Great Britain and the refurbished toilets will enable wheelchairs and disabled shooters to manoeuvre within the facilities.

The total of the refurbishment is £6,376.82 and Fareham Rifle and Pistol Club are requesting £3,200.00; the remainder of the costs will be met from the club's own reserves.

Councillor Howard is supportive of the bid as Chairman of Fareham Town CATs Area. Councillor Trott is also supportive of the bid, however, no view has been received from Councillor Whittle.

Recommendation:

That the application for £3,200.00 from Fareham Borough Council's Community Funding Programme, submitted by Mrs Joy Thornby, Trustee of Fareham Rifle and Pistol Club be approved.

Reason:

This application meets the agreed Community Funding Programme criteria for financial support for community capital projects.
