**Purpose:**

This report presents an application for funding under the Council's Community Fund Programme.

**Executive Summary:**

Mr Tony White, a resident of Fort Fareham Road, Fareham, has requested £1,668.00 for the regeneration of a footpath that runs from Jubilee Court around Fort Fareham to Palmerstone Drive.

This will enable people who live in the housing estate that is situated to the West of Fort Fareham and who use the BRT, to have a path that is no longer muddy and water logged during the winter months.

As the request is from a resident of Fareham they are requesting the full amount of £1,668.00 which is inclusive of VAT.

Councillor Howard as Chairman of Fareham Town CATs Area supports the application. Councillor Steadman is unable to provide a view as he is currently on annual leave.

**Recommendation:**

That the application for £1,668.00 from Fareham Borough Council's Community Funding Programme, submitted by Mr Tony White be approved.

**Reason:**

This application meets the agreed Community Funding Programme criteria for financial support for community capital projects.

**Cost of Proposals:**

The total cost of this project will be £1,668.00 and can be met from within the existing budget for the Community Fund Programme.
