Purpose:

This report presents an application for funding under the Council's Community Fund Programme.

Executive Summary:

Ken Dimmer, Head Coach of Fareham School of Gymnastics has requested £4,969.60 to assist with the purchase of new equipment which is required due to an increase in membership levels.

The equipment the club are wishing to purchase includes a new balance beam and covers, roll mats, Evo flooring (foam based running strip), 3 x foam springboards and 3 x safety crash mats.

The total cost of the project is £6,969.60 and remainder of the funds £2,000 will be met from the Fareham School of Gymnastics Club own funds.

Councillor Steadman and Councillor Howard are supportive of the bid.

Recommendation:

That the application for £4,969.60 from Fareham Borough Council's Community Funding Programme, submitted by Ken Dimmer, Head Coach of Fareham School of Gymnastics be approved.

Reason:

This application meets the agreed Community Funding Programme criteria for financial support for community capital projects.

Cost of Proposals:

The total cost of this project will be £4,969.60 and can be met from within the existing budget for the Community Fund Programme.
